

BYB 1 on 1 Tournament Notes

Game Play Rules

All one-on-one basketball games will be played according to the National Federation Basketball rules with the following exceptions:

1. A coin toss will determine who gets the ball first. The player listed on top of the bracket makes the call.
2. Each game will be 11 points or 15 minutes long. Player must win by only one point.
3. Players score either by one point (inside the 3 point arc) or by two points (outside the 3 point arc).
4. After a basket has been scored or a foul called, a player must put the ball in play at the three-point line above the foul key.
5. All held balls will be put into play behind the three-point line with possession given alternately to each player.
6. Players will have only one attempt at scoring per possession. There will be no defensive or offensive rebound.
7. After a basket, the player scored upon will put the ball in play.
8. On a defensive stop (steal, violation, or missed shot), possessions will alternate and the defensive player will put the ball in play at the top of the key.
9. Fouls will be called by the court monitor/referee.
10. All shooting fouls result in either 1 or 2 free throws, depending where the shot was attempted. Make or miss the defense will get the next possession at the top of the key above the 3 point line. If a player is fouled in the act of shooting and a goal is scored, the foul is disregarded.
11. After a player receives 3 fouls, all following common foul will result in one foul shot.
12. If the game ends in a tie after regulation, the next player to score wins the game. Possession in OT will be determined by a coin toss, this time the player listed on the bottom of the bracket will make the call.
13. No timeouts will be permitted
14. Ceiling and ceiling fixtures (heating unit and lights) are out of bounds and will result in a turnover.
15. Forfeit time is game time. No exceptions.

Other Tournament Rules, Regulations, Notes

Due to social distancing and Covid Safety

- a. Each player will only be permitted one guest.
- b. Each player and guest will have temperature checked prior to entering the BYB Spot.

- c. Each player and guest must sanitize hands upon entry to the BYB spot.

3. Bracket will be released by November 8th, and will be emailed to each participant.
4. Each player must be agree to the Code of Conduct listed below

Code of Conduct

BYB staff who observe poor sportsmanship or bad behavior, including, but not limited to: cursing, threatening language, physical intimidation, fighting or taunting reserve the right to remove a player or spectator from the facility. If ejected, the offender will be asked to leave the premises and may not be permitted back for the remainder of the tournament.
